- No smaller than 8" by 10" and not to exceed 2ft by 3ft
- Submitted with a completed and signed art release form
- Hand made (drawing, collage, painting) or digitally designed
- Free of any profanity or inappropriate images

A scholarship will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners!

The first place winner will receive a \$500 cash scholarship and have their art used on promotional items for the #HateFreeOC campaign. Two runner-ups will receive \$250 cash scholarship. All winners will have their art showcased at our annual AWARDS Gala on May 4, 2017.
